Hospice provides a comprehensive program of palliative and supportive care for the patient and their families to maintain optimal quality of life during the last phases of their terminal illness, including the dying and bereavement stages. Hospice is a team concept consisting of the patient and their family, healthcare professionals, and volunteers focusing on social, physical, spiritual, and emotional care to meet their unique needs.

The Chisholm Trail Hospice team includes specially trained healthcare professionals and volunteers closely working with the patient and family in preparation for death that is satisfactory to them. Our mission is to provide compassionate and exceptional healthcare that promotes comfort care instead of curative goals.

Electing hospice does not mean you are giving up but rather focusing on the quality of life versus the quantity of life. Hospice recognizes dying as an integral part of living and advocates respecting the terminally ill patient's rights.
